CHAPTER I

DEFINITION

Article 1

Definition

For the purpose of these Regulations, the term «NIGHT» means, the period of darkness from 18.15 hours in the evening upto 0600 hours in the following morning.

Article 2

Definition

An additional fee of 50% on the normal day landing fees, be charged on all aircraft landing in the Republic of Somalia Airfields, during the night time; except those aircraft exempted from londingparking fees under Article 8 of Civil Aviation Regulation No. 35 of 5 February 1965.

Article 3

Entry into force

These regulations shall enter into force on the day following the date of their publication in the Official Bulletin.
